Subject investigated: DENTISTS

Survey question numbers: Q37

Description of the perceived need:

There appears to be little urgent need for action here.

There was one mention of dentist in one question, noting that a “dentist” would need to feature within the environmentally sustainable development of the parish.

Summary of relevant survey data:

More buses and normal facilities to sustain life e.g. shop, banking facilities, doctors, dentist etc.

Description of response proposed:

The dental practice in the Madam Green Business Centre is currently solely for private patients, ie does not carry out NHS work. Similar private practices exist in Tangmere and within Sainsbury's at Portfield.
