Feedback on Vision and Objectives

Our thanks to those of you who have given us feedback on our draft Vision and Objectives. There were just a few of you to date but your input will be very helpful.

Broadly you support our overall approach and expressed views on a number of issues:

You want to preserve the semi rural nature of the parish

You want to protect agricultural land and wild life corridors

You want to protect the historical landscape

You stressed the need for cycle paths to connect to Chichester and joined up footpaths to connect the whole parish

You don't want development East of Drayton Lane

You support the need for affordable housing in proportion to the size of the parish but sympathetic and complementary to the look and feel of the parish

You give high marks to St Andrew's church, the Gribble and the Jubilee Hall

You want a local shop

You are concerned about getting to Chichester when the Oving Road lights are closed.

We will take account of your interests and concerns in developing the Neighbourhood Plan.
